year gives us a built in opportunity to set our intentions and goals for the year ahead. It is a natural time to reset and refocus after the hustle and bustle of the holiday season.



The 32-member Commission was authorized by General Conference 2016 and appointed by the Council of Bishops to examine paragraphs in The Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality and exploring options to strengthen the unity of the church. 

Finance Report for November, 2018

I'm pleased to say that November was a much better financial month for Trinity Church. We ended the month in a positive position—not by much--\$225.98—but the numbers were black.

We started the month with a large <u>negative</u> balance of \$3,368.16. And then November's disbursements were also higher than expected at \$28,001.92. However, our receipts were much greater than usual, coming in at a total of \$31,596.06, leaving us with that balance of \$225.98.

Because of our better than expected receipts for the month, I was able to make a \$9,000 payment toward our annual Conference Apportionments. However, going into December we still had a \$13,000 payment due to the West Ohio Conference for those apportionments. We just might get that thing paid off yet.

There's good news when considering apportionments. While our total apportionments (conference and district combined) during 2018 totaled \$40,057, the total levied on our church for 2019 will be \$36,045 or a reduction of \$4,012. It's finally going in the right direction.

I've worked up the new budget for 2019 and overall the general operating fund has been reduced by \$8,077 for the year. What that means is that to meet the 2019 budget, we need to receive an offering of \$4,833 per week in the general fund. Sadly, we did not hit that mark in 2018, but I'm optimistic that we will be able to step it up and realize that figure throughout the new year.

As I write this report next month, I'll be giving you a December report along with a recap of 2018.

And as you include Trinity Church in your daily prayers, please ask for its financial viability. That's what allows the church to provide the various ministries we all desire and deserve.
