Greetings Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we finish up our Lenten journey we come to the cross of Jesus, the empty tomb, and the upper room. You know, I think all three of these locations in the life of Jesus give us insight into the love of God. As we arrive at the cross of Jesus we see God's loving sacrifice poured out for each of us. A love so

great that even his own son wasn't too much to give. And yet, there's more... as we come to the empty tomb we see the glory of God made known to the world through the resurrection of Jesus. It is God's spirit that brings God's great love for the world into full view. Death wasn't too much for our God, sin didn't hold him back, a tomb couldn't keep him in. That's the vast and overwhelming love of God that consumes us each Easter as we celebrate the resurrection. Then as we turn to the upper room and see the disciples riddled with fear, frustration, and doubt. We also see Jesus come to be among them. He offers them peace, forgiveness, and of course, love. He breathes the



spirit of God upon them and invites them into service as he gives them the great commission.

These three vignettes into the life of Christ give us a greater understanding of the Trinity and the love that flows between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. And friends, it's that love that empowers our actions in this life. As we care for others, as we share the good news of the Resurrection - we become conduits of God's love for the world. That's what the Easter season is all about. The 50 days after Easter when we celebrate the Resurrection (The Great 50 days) give us time to rejoice and experience what it truly means to say "Christ is risen!" As "Easter people," we celebrate and ponder the birth of the Church and gifts of the Spirit (Pentecost), and how we are to live as faithful disciples of Christ. Easter isn't just a one day celebration. It's a way of life. Living our lives as Easter People takes intentionality and discipline. After all, we know it's easy to rejoice for one day and then settle into a routine of faith practice. But truly living out the Resurrection each moment of each day takes a deeply rooted faith in Jesus Christ. As we move through the great 50 days of Eastertide, I invite you to notice the evidence of the Resurrection in your midst. From the new blooms of spring flowers, to the refreshment that each rain drop brings, new life is springing up all around us. How then shall we, the people of God, respond? Isaiah 43:19 calls to us "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

In what areas of your life is God doing a new thing? Perhaps it is in your family as you welcome new members, and celebrate new additions. Maybe it is in your lifestyle as you embrace a new stage of life, or maybe it is in our community as new faces move in across the street. Wherever God is moving in your midst, I know he is calling you to come and meet him there! Our Lord delights in the moments when we perceive his movements and join in his mighty acts of salvation in this life. As we invite others into the grace of God by extending Christ's love, mercy, and forgiveness to others, we are rejuvenated and redeemed. So my sisters and brothers, consider this your invitation to look for the new thing God is doing and then go and join him in that thing. Our lives must proclaim the old Easter hymn, "You ask me how I know He lives? He lives, within my heart!"

Finance Report for February, 2019

Not much to report this month—although—the news is much better. We ended the month of February with a positive balance of \$3199.44.

You will remember that we ended January \$98.11 in the red. Then our receipts in February totaled \$19,186.22. Fortunately, our expenses during the same time period were considerably less, only \$15,888.67 leaving us in the black by the amount above. If we have another good month, I'll be able to start paying on our Conference Apportionments payable to the West Ohio Conference. This year those apportionments total \$29,431—no small piece of change. With your help and commitment we'll make it again this year.
